- ❖ a letter of recommendation from your school, written by a senior official, such as your principal, guidance counsellor or teacher;
- ❖ two letters of support or confirmation from the community group, groups or individuals who can attest to the school and community leadership on which this application is based.
- ❖ a transcript of your academic record;

*Applicants selected as finalists will be notified by the end of April 2010, and interviewed by a selection panel in May Awards will be presented in May.*
